BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Act 294 of 2020 deletes the Parish from the statutes governing the Shreveport Caddo Parish Metropolitan Planning Commission as of January 1, 2022. The Parish will need a planning and zoning commission to act on zoning matters after that. Creation of a Caddo Parish Planning and Zoning Commission will put in place that commission. Creating the commission now will allow it to advise on the any work done this year on preparing for next year.

FINANCIAL IMPACT AND SOURCE OF FUNDING

There is no financial impact and no funding anticipated to be required by this ordinance. Members of the proposed planning and zoning commission will serve without pay.

EFFECT(S) OF PROPOSED ACTION

Create a parish planning and zoning commission composed entirely of members from outside the incorporated areas of the parish. This year the commission will serve in an advisory capacity and beginning January 2, 2022 will be the official planning and zoning commission for the unincorporated areas of the parish. The commission will serve in an advisory capacity until then.

ALTERNATIVES/STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Wait until 2022 to create the planning and zoning commission or not create a planning and zoning commission at all.
