

RESOLUTION NO. 59 OF 2021

BY THE CADDO PARISH COMMISSION:

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CADDO PARISH HOMELAND SECURITY AND THE LOUISIANA NATIONAL GUARD TO ASSIST LOCAL IMMIGRATION MEASURES, AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO.

WHEREAS, on or about July 15, 2021, buses of Haitian immigrants were dropped off in Shreveport, Caddo Parish, by the U.S. Department of Immigration and Customs Enforcement with no notice to local officials; and

WHEREAS, local officials should be notified so that any necessary security measures can be put in place.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Caddo Parish Commission in due, regular and legal session convened, that it hereby requests the Caddo Parish Department of Homeland Security and the Louisiana National Guard to respond to all instances of immigrants arriving in Caddo Parish so that they can coordinate proper monitoring and security measures if needed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution shall be sent to the Adjutant General of the Louisiana and the Caddo Director of Homeland Security.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any provision or item of this resolution or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this resolution are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
