<p>Ordinance 6190 of 2022</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 6071 OF 2021 RELATIVE TO THE CADDO PARISH PLANNING COMMISSION, TO PROVIDE FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATES OF THE CADDO PARISH PLANNING COMMISSION, AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO</p>

<b>BACKGROUND INFORMATION</b>	
<p>Ordinance 6071 of 2021 created the Caddo Parish Planning Commission. The Planning Commission would serve in an advisory function until January 1, 2022 and then would take over the duties and authority of a planning and zoning commission as provided by state law. The ordinance provided that members of the Caddo Parish Planning Commission would be residents living outside the boundaries of incorporated municipalities. This proposed ordinance would “sunset” the Caddo Parish Planning Commission on June 30, 2022</p>	
<b>FINANCIAL IMPACT AND SOURCE OF FUNDING</b>	
<p>The proposed ordinance would not have a significant financial impact since it does not affect the zoning and subdivision ordinances themselves.</p>	
<b>EFFECT(S) OF PROPOSED ACTION</b>	
<p>Sunsets the Caddo Parish Planning Commission on June 30, 2022.</p>	
<b>ALTERNATIVES/STAFF RECOMMENDATION</b>	
<p>Choose not to adopt the ordinance and allow the Caddo Parish Planning Commission to continue to exist. If appointments to the Planning Commission were made, it would address issues with zoning and subdivisions past June 30, 2022.</p> <p>Staff has no recommendation.</p>
