**WHEREAS**, she is also remembered for the warmth of her smile, her wisdom, and by her devotion to her family, her church, and her community; she will truly be missed.

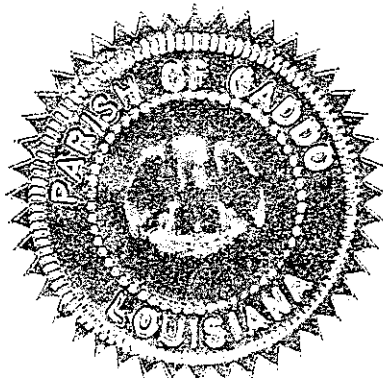
