<b>TITLE</b>	Ordinance 6203 of 2022
	AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN EASEMENT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY AGREEMENT WITH CADDEAUX GATHERING, LLC REGARDING A PIPELINE THROUGH AND UNDER PARISH PROPERTY LOCATED IN SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 15 WEST, CADDO PARISH, LOUISIANA,
<b>DATE:</b> February 10, 2022	<b>ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT:</b> Legal for Public Works
<b>BACKGROUND INFORMATION</b>	Caddeaux Gathering LLC has requested that the Parish grant it a pipeline servitude under a 2.5 acre tract of Parish property located just off Backpath Road south of Blanchard Furrh Road. The pipeline will be installed entirely by boring and not by open trenching such that the surface of the property will not be disturbed. The Parish property is not used for any purpose and is not adjacent to any other Parish property.
<b>FINANCIAL IMPACT AND SOURCE OF FUNDING</b>	No financial impact as the pipeline company will pay the Parish \$400 per rod for the servitude.
<b>EFFECT(S) OF PROPOSED ACTION</b>	Granting the servitude will provide the pipeline company with a means to install a pipeline. The restriction of not trenching will mean that the surface of the property will not be disturbed.
<b>ALTERNATIVES/STAFF RECOMMENDATION</b>	The alternative is to refuse to grant the servitude. Staff recommendation is to grant the servitude.
