

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL SESSION OF  
THE CADDO PARISH COMMISSION  
HELD ON THE 26th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2022

The Caddo Parish Commission met in a Special Session, on the above date, at 10:00 a.m., in the Government Chambers, with Mr. Atkins, presiding, and the following members in attendance constituting a quorum: Commissioners Atkins, Burrell, Chavez, Epperson, Gage-Watts, Hopkins, Lazarus, Taliaferro, and Young (9). ABSENT: Commissioners Jackson, Johnson, and Jones (3).

The invocation was given by Mr. Hopkins, and Mrs. Gage-Watts led the Commission in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**NEW BUSINESS**

It was **moved by Mr. Hopkins**, seconded by Mr. Lazarus, *that Ordinance No. 6260 of 2022, an ordinance to correct the Special Purpose Millages for Juvenile Court and Courthouse Maintenance previously adopted, as allowed by Article VII, Section 23 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974 and LA R.S. 47:1705 (B), levying and imposing taxes and assessments for 2022 on all the property subject to taxation in the Parish of Caddo, and to otherwise provide with respect thereto* be introduced and the public hearing set for October 13, 2022.


Mrs. Bryant explained that when the millages were originally passed, the rates that were used were the ones that they had before the renewal election. Since the millage has been renewed, those rates have to be used. She also explained that the rates that have to be used are slightly lower than the rates that they had in place.

Mrs. Gage-Watts wanted to know if this is going to increase the deficit with Juvenile Services. Mrs. Bryant explained that it will assess the revenue that they've estimated in the fund, but won't necessarily increase the deficit.

At this time, Mr. Hopkins' motion carried, as shown by the following roll call votes: AYES: Commissioners Atkins, Burrell, Chavez, Epperson, Gage-Watts, Hopkins, Lazarus, Taliaferro, and Young (9). NAYS: None (0). ABSENT: Commissioners Jackson, Johnson, and Jones (3). ABSTAIN: None (0).
